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## COMPETITION DETAILS

- Age divisions: U/7's & 8's up to U/15's & 16's  
(team places in 15's/16's limited. Preference given to teams returning from RALC 14's & 15's)
- Up to 10 players able to be registered per team, with 5 on court at any one time.
- **18 round competition starting Friday 10<sup>th</sup> of September 2010 to March 2011**  
(no games during school holidays) followed by direct qualification semi's, and finals  
**(no additional payment is required for semi's and finals).**
- Games will be on Friday afternoons/ evenings, with start times ranging from 4pm to 10pm  
(game start times will be as appropriate to age as is possible).
- All players must be registered, with details present upon team registration card and team ID sheet before being able to play match fixtures (team cards are organized by team manager through RALC).
- ALL forfeits incur a team penalty of \$68.50 (first 2 are deducted from the team bond)

- RALC Team Registration and limited injury insurance
- Team forfeit bond of \$137 (refunded at conclusion of competition if no forfeits are accrued).

## HOW TO REGISTER YOUR TEAM

- Complete the attached Team Registration Form, Team ID Card, and RALC Junior Indoor Soccer Codes of Conduct form, and **return them with payment** to RALC reception by Wednesday September 1<sup>st</sup>
- Registration period will start Monday July 19<sup>th</sup> and finish on Wednesday September 1<sup>st</sup>. Registrations/ payments can be taken Monday to Friday from 9am until 8pm.
- **Team spaces within the competition are allocated on a first in, first served basis**

## WHAT TO BRING TO REGISTRATION ?

1. \$1280 per team
2. One completed Team Registration Form, completed Team ID Card, and a signed and acknowledged RALC Codes of Conduct form.
3. Proof of age/identity for each player/coach/manager new to RALC **must** be supplied

# RALC Sporting Competition Participant

## Codes of Conduct

(The term "participant" refers to a player, coach, manager, or spectator)

- Participants will always play by the rules and RALC by-laws
- Participants will participate for the enjoyment of the game, not to please parents or coaches, and not for the sole reason of winning
- Participants will never argue with an official. The match official's decision will be final. Participants will accept a decision, correct or otherwise. If a participant disagrees with a decision they will inform the captain, coach or manager, who may calmly ask the game official for an explanation of the call during a break in play
- Participants are expected to control their temper. They must understand that verbal/physical abuse of other participants and officials, sledging other participants (from the field, sidelines, or grandstand), and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permissible behaviours in any sport
- Participants will work equally hard for themselves and their team
- Participants will be "good sports" and acknowledge all good plays whether they are made by their team or by the opposition
- Participants will treat all players in their sport as they wish to be treated. They will not bully or take unfair advantage of another participant
- Participants will cooperate with their coach, team members, match officials, and opponents
- Participants will display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat
- Participants (players, spectators, and team officials) will not arrive intoxicated or drink alcohol at a sporting event at The Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre. Participants are also reminded that RALC is a non-smoking facility.
- Participants will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability, or cultural background
- Participants will thank and shake hands with the opposition, and thank the match official at the conclusion of each game
