



COACHES & MANAGERS UPDATE – July 21st 2010 EDITION. . . .

1) From RDP Committee – How the post season works for all bar U8 and below!

Please see attached doc taken from the blue handbook.

Essentially, all points are reset and the top 4 teams play each other once with the top 2 playing the grand final. (Think of World Cup group stage).

The date for the grand final for GHFA should be the 21st weather permitting and for NWSWF the 22nd August, assuming *no more wash outs*.

If there is a washout – then we may lose a semi or the GF is moved to 28th/29th. Confirmation to come from GHFA and NWSWF.

The premiers must be present to accept the premiership trophy even if they do not make the grand final.

NOTE:: If a team does not make the top 4 then they have to play a Pennant competition. See attached, with all details of post season play for GHFA. For the NWSWF is exactly the same except for the following changes / additions.

24.2.3 In Championship Grand Finals, other than Under 9, Under 10 and Under 11, where two teams are drawn at full time, a maximum of ten (10) minutes extra time each way will be played. During that extra time the first team to score will be declared the winner. If no score is recorded in extra time a penalty shootout shall be played to determine the winner. In U9-U11 Football after extra time with no score the teams are declared equal Junior Champions.

24.3.4 Pennant Competition winners in each division or grade will be determined by a play off (to be known as the Pennant Final) between those teams that finish 1st & 2nd at the end of the Pennant Competition Round Robin set out above.

24.3.5 Placings in the Pennant Round Robin and winners in the Pennant Final are to be determined by the same rules applying to the Championship Round Robins and Grand Finals.

24.3.7 All Pennant Finals will be scheduled to be played on Grand Final Day/s each season.
